Amazing Grace

Bringing the message of God's grace on Australian radio



*Amazing grace, how sweet the sound
That saved a wretch like me.
I once was lost but now am found,
Was blind but now I see.*

So commences the famous hymn by former slave trader, John Newton. Newton had lived a godless, self-indulgent life, but came to a deep conviction of sin, and was led to repentance and faith in Christ. John Newton knew the great debt he owed to God, who had found him when he was lost in sin, and given him spiritual sight when he could not see.

Amazing Grace is also the title of weekly radio broadcasts by the Presbyterian Reformed Church. It describes the purpose of the radio programs – to broadcast the amazing saving grace of God to sinners. The gospel of Christ is a message of grace to everyone who trusts for their security with God not on their own goodness, but on the free grace of God.

It is our prayer that *Amazing Grace* programs will be a blessing to Christians who hear them, and will also be used by God to bring that gospel of grace to listeners who have never considered how much they need God's grace, and how freely that grace is provided through the death of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Why do we do radio evangelism?

- ❖ For people who are enquiring about Christianity, a radio program is an unthreatening, easily accessible, readily available way to hear the gospel of salvation by faith in Christ alone.
- ❖ For 'shut in' Christians, radio can provide a ministry of encouragement to those who love to hear the gospel told, and told, and told again. (*We know – we get letters from them telling us so!*).
- ❖ Occasionally, the gospel is also heard 'by accident' – by people who never intended to listen to a Christian message but who, in God's providence, have tuned in when the program is on air. (*We know – we have the testimony of a member of the PRC who was converted many years ago in exactly this way!*)

How can you support the ministry of Amazing Grace?

- ❖ **Listen** to *Amazing Grace* if it is broadcast in your area.
- ❖ **Tell** your friends about *Amazing Grace*.
Talk to them about the current series of messages, and encourage them to listen too.
Use the program as part of your own, personal evangelism to friends who are uncomfortable fronting up to a church service. Listening to the program at home can be much less threatening to 'un-churched' people.
- ❖ **Pray** for *Amazing Grace*
Pray that people who are not Christians will listen in.
Pray that the program will be attractive and arresting, and will draw people to listen.
Pray that the gospel messages will be clear and compelling.
Pray for those who prepare and record the messages.
Pray for Graeme Hulls as he assembles and records the whole program every week.
Pray for the task of copying and distributing program CDs to stations around the country and overseas.
Pray that the broadcasts themselves will be technically clear and that reception will be good over a wide listening area.
Pray that the program archive of *Amazing Grace* messages – available globally through our web site – will be used to further spread the gospel.
Pray for the follow-up of letters and eMails arising from the broadcasts and from the web site.
- ❖ **Extend** the coverage of *Amazing Grace* broadcasts.

We will provide interested radio stations (either direct or through you) with a promotion pack including sample programs, information about program content, and technical information on the recording, distribution and broadcasting of the programs.
